

### Overview

The State of Alaska is publishing information from the statewide accounting system on the web. This is part of a national trend for governments to develop websites that **allow constituents to view financial information in searchable formats**. Such websites are widely considered to improve transparency into the financial operations of government.

Financial information that can be found on this website consists of the following details:

- Vendors and grantees to whom non-confidential payments were issued are provided in the report. Recipient information presented includes the name and location of the vendor or grantee, the purpose of the payment, and the department that issued it.
- Most payment information is aggregated by each disbursement; however, some information is aggregated based on the expenditure type to prevent the disclosure of confidential information.

- The purpose of the payment in the form of the Expense Type.
