



### What's not in FPDS

- Copies of entire contracts, statements of work, and subcontracting data
- Data from agencies not subject to FPDS reporting requirements according to the FAR
- Purchase Card data
- Interagency agreements
- Grants data
- Cooperative agreements
- Training authorizations
- Imprest fund transactions
- Transactions related only to non-appropriated funds
- Most transactions that involve Government bills of lading or transportation requests
- Requisitions transferring supplies within or among departments or agencies
- Tracking functionality related to making awards or to tracking dollars





## **Search Tips**

#### The FPDS-NG system offers three features that can assist you in your search.

- 1) **Wildcard**: A wildcard is a character that can be used in a search to represent one or more characters. In FPDS-NG, "%" is the wildcard character.
- For instance, entering "COM%" in the search field will return anything starting with COM, such as COMpany, COMplete, COMmunication, and COMmunications. Entering "COMM%" will eliminate COMpany and COMplete from the search returns. Entering "%COM%" will return anything with COM contained within the word, such as dataCOMmunication.
- 2) **Ellipsis:** When more choices or search options are available, you will see the ellipsis look-up feature. Simply click on that button to open a new screen with additional information/options. You can also combine the Wildcard and Ellipsis features to narrow your search by typing partial information in the field and then selecting the ellipsis feature.
