## Why SAM – Contract Award?

### System for Award Management (SAM):

- ❖ All entities who will be receiving federal funds either through a contract and/or grant shall be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM) before an award can be executed or a payment processed for payment.

#### FAR 4.1100 Scope

This subpart prescribes policies and procedures for requiring contractor registration in the System for Award Management (SAM) to—

- (a) Increase visibility of vendor sources (including their geographical locations) for specific supplies and services; and
- (b) Establish a common source of vendor data for the Government.

#### FAR 4.1102 Policy

(a) Offerors and quoters are required to be registered in SAM at the time an offer or quotation is submitted in order to comply with the annual representations and certifications requirements ...

(c) Contracting officers shall use the legal business name or "doing business as" name and physical address from the contractor's SAM registration for the provided unique entity identifier to identify the contractor in section A of the contract schedule, similar sections of non-uniform contract formats and agreements, and all corresponding forms and data exchanges. Contracting officers shall make no changes to the data retrieved from SAM.




## Renewing Your Profile

### ❖ Information needed to renew your entity profile in SAM:

- ✓ SAM username/password
- ✓ Tax Identification Number (EIN or Social Security Number) *(If Changing)*
- ✓ Banking information: Bank Routing & Account numbers plus bank phone number *(If Changing)*
- ✓ NAICS Codes: <https://www.census.gov/naics/> *(If Adding additional codes)*
- ✓ PSC Codes: <https://support.outreachsystems.com/resources/tables/pscs/>
- ✓ Gross receipts averaged over the last five years
- ✓ Average number of employees over a 24 month period


} This information should be updated every year to determine size.

- ❖ Creating an Entity Administrator Appointment Letter (EAAL)
  - ✓ Complete & Notarize Entity Administrator Letter




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# Updating Login.gov



**Login.gov Tips:**


- To update/add access information go to login.gov website directly – do not start from SAM.gov
- If you no longer have access to the email used for login.gov – you will have to delete the login.gov account
- If you no longer have access to the cell phone listed for receiving the code via text, you will have to delete the login.gov account.

Points of Contact updates are effective immediately. This update does not replace your required annual entity renewal. If you want to update any other information, you must update/renew your entire entity registration.

Updates to your entity registration information generally require an IRS and CAGE validation, which can take up to ten business days. Once you submit an update, you cannot make changes until the submitted registration is processed.


An entity registration must be updated / renewed every 365 days to remain active and will expire if you do not renew it in time. An expired registration may affect your ability to do business with the federal government.

### Confirm CAGE code

The Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) code is a five-character, alpha-numeric identifier assigned to entities located within the United States and its outlying areas by the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) CAGE Program.

The CAGE code is different from the Unique Entity ID assigned in SAM.gov. It is used by the federal government for procurement and acquisition processes, like invoicing or pre-award verification.

(a) In determining a concern's number of employees, SBA counts all individuals employed on a full-time, part-time, or other basis. This includes employees obtained from a temporary employee agency, professional employee organization or leasing concern...

(b) **Where the size standard is number of employees, the method for determining a concern's size includes the following principles:**

- (1) **The average number of employees of the concern is used (including the employees of its domestic and foreign affiliates) based upon numbers of employees for each of the pay periods for the preceding completed 24 calendar months.**
- (2) Part-time and temporary employees are counted the same as full-time employees.
- (3) If a concern has not been in business for 24 months, the average number of employees is used for each of the pay periods during which it has been in business.





- ❖ After your SAM.gov profile is active – go back and update your SBA Small Business Profile. There is a webinar recording “Supersize Your SBA Profile” posted on the Alaska APEX Accelerator Website under “on-demand training.”
- ❖ Your SAM profile must be updated yearly! If you have a contract and your SAM profile expires, you will not be paid! Payments are suspended until the profile has been activated.
- ❖ Beware third-party providers trying to sell you services. If they say call and there is an 800 telephone number – it isn’t government. Also watch the email addresses. Any emails that say your “profile is not complete” is also an email to ignore.
- ❖ SAM will send an email 60 days before your profile will expire. Nowhere in the email does it say to call them.
- ❖ Make sure that all NAICS codes in solicitations that you wish to bid on have been added to your SAM profile. It is the only way to verify you are a Small Business for the associated size standard for that NAICS code.
